Drop off and Pick Up
 Camp programmes begin at 9 a.m. Please drop your child off at the camp sign in area outside the school office. Children must be picked up promptly after programs or extended evening care.

Extended Care
 Before care is available from 7:30 a.m. – 9 a.m. for \$7.50 per morning. After care is available from 4 p.m. – 6 p.m. for \$12.00 per afternoon. The cost for using both before and after care is \$17.00 per day or \$75.00 per week. There will be a late pick-up fee of \$20 after 6 p.m.

Lunch and Snacks
 Campers must provide their own lunches, snacks and drinks. Please ensure that all lunches and snacks are nut/peanut free.

Camp Instruction
 Your child's camp experience is prepared and delivered by our qualified and dedicated Fern Hill School teachers.

Confirmation
 Once a completed registration and deposit along with a post-dated cheque is received, please assume confirmation in the camp unless contacted by the camp director.
